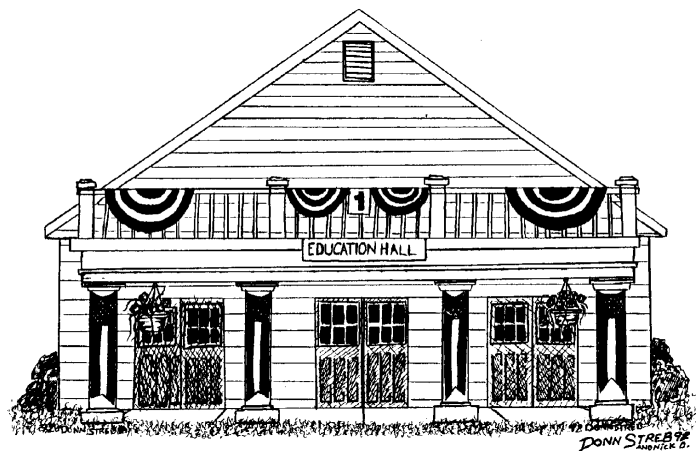


173rd Canfield Fair

GENERAL RULES and GUIDELINES for TEACHERS

Due to the large number of entries received for judging and display at Educational Hall and in order to display them in an appealing manner, we request that teachers abide by the following rules and guidelines when submitting student work:

1. All premium entries are free.
2. All work exhibited must be the **individual** efforts of a student regularly enrolled and project must have been produced during the 2018-2019 school year.
3. **"Pre-Judge"** all projects and submit only the best.
4. **No class projects.** Individual student work only.
5. **One entry** per student will be accepted.
6. All artwork must fit inside your assigned district booth. Booth sizes vary from 12-21 feet long left to right, 6 1/2 feet tall from platform to ceiling and the platform is 30 inches deep. The platform is where you could display small ceramics and items that cannot be stapled to the walls. Please contact Brie Little for the exact length of your assigned booth.
7. **Projects should not be larger than 36" in size.**

Please limit the number of display/presentation board projects as space is limited and these are difficult to display.

8. Paper entries should be mounted on cardstock or heavy paper with a visible 1/2" to 1" border. This will allow space for stapling to the walls without damaging the artwork.
9. Educational Hall is dusty; you may want to consider laminating projects to protect them.
10. Please use good judgment when submitting very fragile pieces or projects. Ceramic and Paper Mache projects are particularly difficult to protect. We cannot guarantee against damage.
11. **Each entry must have a completed district identification label or tag attached to it.** MCECSC will supply building principals with labels and tags for teachers. Attach labels to flat artwork pieces and securely tie tags to other submissions. The student's name, teacher, and school building should also be written on the back of each entry in case the labels or tags come off.

12. Entries made with **food items will not be accepted** (i.e., gingerbread houses, macaroni, beans, corn, salt, flour, dog food, etc.) because food products tend to attract insects and rodents.
13. Entries may be delivered on **August 13-16, 2018** to the Canfield Fair, Educational Hall, Building #1, 7265 Columbiana-Canfield Rd., Canfield, OH 44406. **9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.**
ALL ARTWORK IS TO BE HUNG BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT ART TEACHER.
We will have students on staff available to help assist you.
14. Student entries will be judged prior to the Fair by art instructors not currently teaching in at any participating school. High School students hired by the Fair Board through MCECSC will assist with the judging process and place winning ribbons on the proper entries.
15. Premium Awards:

1st Place - Blue Ribbon	2nd Place - Red Ribbon
3rd Place & Honorable Mention – White or Pink Ribbon	All Other Entries - Participation Ribbon
16. **The on-line Premium Entry form must be completed by each teacher for each project submitted.** If this is not done, the project will not be considered for judging.
 - To submit students' work, go to MCECSC website: **www.mahoningesc.org**
 - Choose the Canfield Fair link for the Premium Entry Form.
 - One form for each entry must be filled out completely to be accepted.
 - Enter information in each field and then choose SUBMIT in the left hand corner. Continue this process for each entry.
 - The teacher submitting the information is also verifying that this is the student's original work and was produced during the 2018-2019 school year.
17. **Teachers are to report to Educational Hall to tear down their own displays.** Tear down times will be on Tuesday, September 3rd (the day after Labor Day) from 3:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. Please contact Brie Little if additional arrangements need to be made.
